
Cleaning a Motor Starter Switch

 Remove the end bell where the wires come out. There will be four long bolts and nuts holding the motor together (below).




 With just the starter end removed, there should be a white plastic terminal board. You can either loosen this board or if you can get to the starter points, (they are on a long copper piece) they open up after the motor gets to a certain speed.



 Take an emery file and sand the contacts to polish up the copper contacts (below).



Reassemble the end bell and install the bolts/nuts.
